A query regarding maintenance of a brick boundary wall was received, members agreed that if any maintenance to the brick wall has to be carried out the fence recently installed could be removed for work to be carried out.

c) Horeston Recreation Ground – Play Equipment

The 2 sets of plans have been on public display at the Bonfire Event last week and a few comments have been received.

Members looked at the plans received from two contractors and agreed that Cllr McGuinness ask for the plans to be revised to include and omit certain items of play equipment and to produce 2 plans, phase 1 and Phase 2.

The plans are to go out to public consultation, they will be on display at the Co-op and the Doctors and then the children of Horsley Woodhouse School will be consulted.

Planning Permission will then be sought after a decision has been made.
